Areas of concern or issues to track	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Support expressed for the marine plan, the work that went into it, and the need for marine protection. Clarification sought about what can and cannot happen in different types of PMZs. Concern about the impact of the plan on recreational fishing, particularly to areas that are readily accessible from local communities, e.g., Yakoun estuary. Interest in options for marine-based alternative energy as an alternative to burning 	

<p>diesel e.g., tidal power in Masset Inlet, wind power. Also, other possibilities that benefit the marine environment e.g., de-barking logs and burning wood waste.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Need for infrastructure to support economic growth e.g., in marine tourism. • Need for assessment of plan impacts on local interests/ sectors. • Concern about the short timeline for providing feedback. Encouragement to participants to provide input on the plan. • Desire for equity in the outcomes/impacts of the plan. 	
<p>Other notes Generally positive reaction to the plan, with most concern related to local access to fishing and options for alternative energy. Expressed need for assessment of plan impacts on local activities and interests.</p>
